*The Town Attorney* said it is very difficult to set any regular standards for a Family Subdivision; it can potentially create liability issues for the Town.

*Surdam:* The Planning Board had said previously that they are willing to work with Farmers who desire to subdivide parcels for their family and still follow the subdivision law.
