- Phase 2 of the Pool Rehab Project is the Bathhouse- The contract portion of the project was scheduled to be complete by now and mostly is. There are three items left on the punch list, one is a door that had to be special ordered, a light post base repair which will be finished when they come back to install the door, and a needed entry light switch that is a safety issue which was not a part of the design plans.
- Pool Bathhouse Rehab Periodic Estimate No 4- Covering construction period May1st 2018 through May 31st 2018 for \$41,372.02. Motion to authorize Supervisor Surdam to sign and return Owner Approval Periodic Estimate No 4. Discussion.
- Rensselaer County Health Dept. Project Inspection- They are requiring additional concrete work in the shower drain area to stop the water from running in against the building and directing all of it toward the drain before they will sign off on the project and issue a pool permit. They are also requiring we repair any trip hazards from uneven concrete slabs. Motion to have Rick Taber make the required concrete repairs and to move the shower drain line to the new location away from the door.

- Pool Shower- It was decided the shower was too close to the doorway and because we need to replace the concrete in that area it only makes sense to move the drain so we can move the shower. We obtained an estimate from the plumbing contractor of over \$1,000 to move the shower and repair the holes in the wall. Councilperson William Hanselman who is a contractor by trade not only offered to do the job at no cost to the Town he has completed it!! Thank you Bill!!
- 2018 PFOA follow up Blood Draw is being rolled out by NYS DOH scheduled to begin in June. Blood draw will be available to everyone in the community previously tested or not, by appointment through Twin Rivers Medical on Danforth St. or Southwestern Vermont Medical Center. Additional information will be available very soon. We are still waiting for the official roll out.
