Step one of the process is to contact NYSDOH online at <a href="www.health.ny.gov/hoosick">www.health.ny.gov/hoosick</a> OR you can call 1-800-801-8092 Monday- Friday, 8:30-4:30. You will need to provide the names, birthdates, and contact information of your household who want to participate. You will then be mailed test orders that you will need to take to either Twin Rivers Medical on Danforth St. or Southwestern Vermont Medical Center in Bennington to have blood drawn. The test does not require fasting. There is no cost to you for this blood test.
