Route 67 over Batten Kill Railroad and Owl Kill
Town of White Creek, Washington County

Dear Supervisor Shay,

We are pleased to advise that, weather permitting, our contractor is scheduled to begin work on the above-referenced project on Monday, April 8.

As Project Manager Jeff Fisher detailed in his September 2017 letter to you, this work will include removal and replacement of the Route 67 bridge, utility relocations and replacement of highway approach guide rail.

During the bridge replacement effort, the bridge will be closed with two separate detour routes, one for cars/light trucks and one for larger trucks and tractor trailers. As shown on the enclosed map, the car/light truck detour will use New Turnpike and North Old State Roads, while the large truck/tractor trailer route will use State Routes 67, 40, 142, 7 and 22.

Our contractor is scheduled to start on April 8 with minor widening, paving and striping of North Old State Road. The road will remain open to traffic during this work, with alternating one way traffic in the work areas controlled by flagpersons.

The bridge closure period is scheduled to begin on Monday, April 29 and last for approximately six (6) months, until October 29.

We will be sure to advise you if the timetable for this work changes significantly due to weather or other unanticipated conditions encountered in the field.
