

Town of Hoosick Zoning Board Meeting  
August 3, 2020

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jim Hoag at 7 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Mike Bailey to approve the July Zoning Board minutes, seconded by Fred Pirie, all in favor, motion granted.

The Zoning Board discussed the Waste Water Facility located across the river from the Brown's Brewery. The Zoning Board stated this property is in A/R and the property is shaped like an L away from the property. The end of the L goes toward the west. Mr. Brown is interested in this property and the Zoning Board stated there is no deed for the property. Mr. Brown talked to the Building Inspector about the process of having a Waste Water Facility on the property.

Ken Laporte appeared before the Zoning Board to discuss the odor from the Hemp Factory in North Hoosick. He stated that the smell is still very bad and thought there was a stop order for the business. He wanted to know who enforces the stop order. The Board suggested he go to the Town Board to see why the business is still operating if a stop order was placed by the Building Inspector.

The Zoning Board reviewed the Building Permits that Building Inspector Fran Rogers has issued.

The Zoning Board discussed a Car Rust proofing business on the property of Bryon Hess on the Hill Road. The Zoning Board said he needs to be in compliance for a repair shop. Jim Hoag will check into if this business is considered a repair shop. Fran Rogers will be calling Mr. Hess to talk about what he is actually doing on the property and notify Mr. Hoag.

A motion was made by Mike Bailey to adjourn the August Zoning Board meeting, seconded by Andy Beaty, all in favor, motion granted.
